We are a member club and affiliated with Tall Clubs International and currently have 80+ members locally. Tall club members take pride in fostering tall awareness through community involvement in projects, activities, and through their official charities, TCl Foundation, The Marfan Foundation, Sacramento Zoo Parent program.

This is an academic scholarship for tall students. The continuing education scholarships are open to those students who have completed at least 1 year of college or trade school education, are 21 years of age or older, meet the official height requirements of The Sacramento Tall Club (5'10" for women, 6'2" for men) and are attending a two or four year accredited institution of higher learning in the fall of 2016.

<u>Please be sure to complete the whole application packet</u> and submit all required paperwork by June 1st of the given scholarship year. Your unofficial transcripts, recommendations, etc. may be sealed envelopes, but **MUST** be included in your packet.
